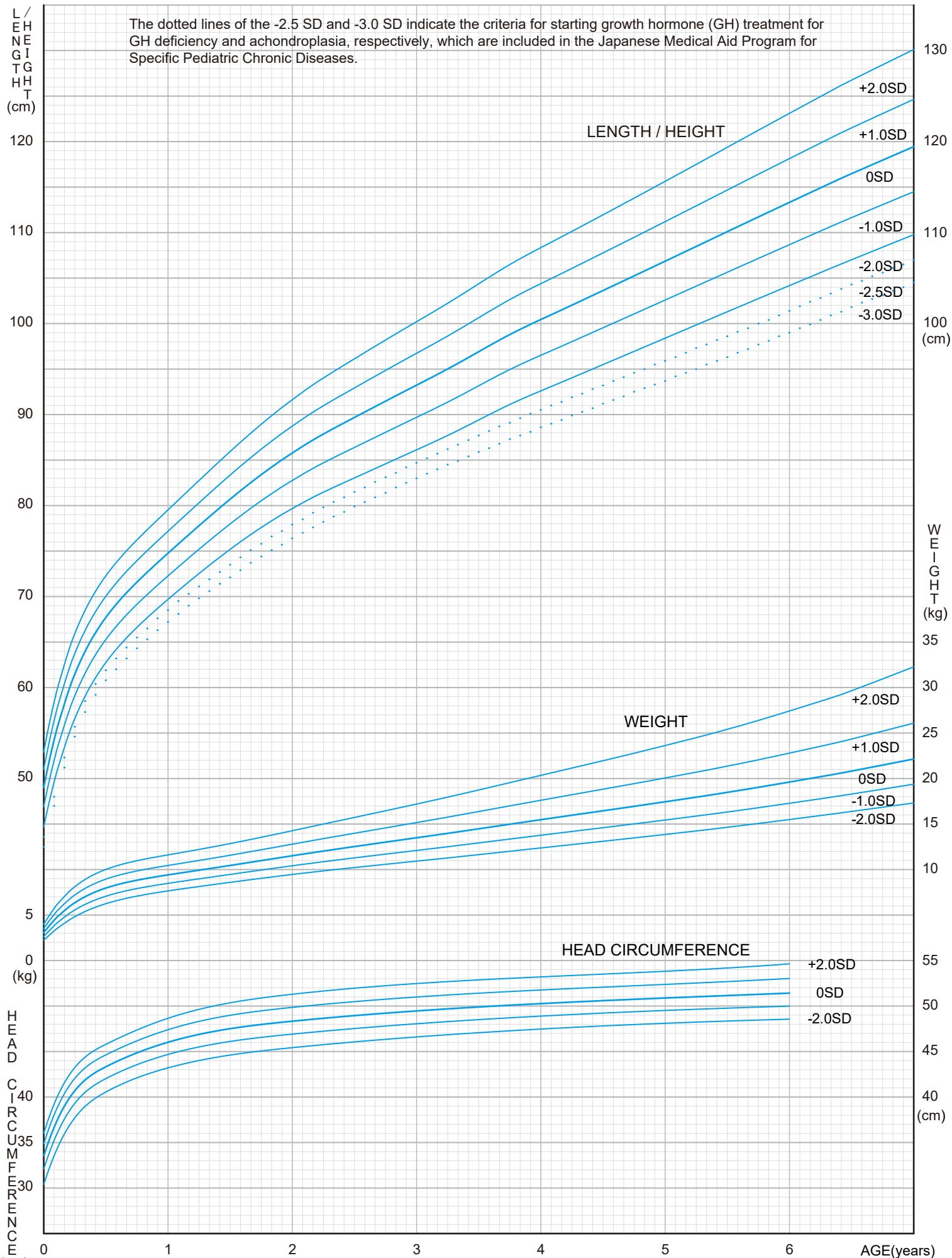


# Cross-sectional Growth Chart for Boys (0-6 yrs)
